The association was firmly established and continued throughout Zach's time with TOCA, the Porsche Carrera Cup, and Formula 3 Championships.

TOOLORDERS INTERVIEW

Paul O'Neill was a rising star in the British Touring Car Championship (BTCC) when he was diagnosed with diabetes. Until Paul could control the effects of the disease his racing licence was suspended. Diabetes only strengthened his resolve to come back, and more importantly, win.

After two seasons of guest drives in the Porsche Carrera Cup and the BTCC for Techspeed and Motorbase Performance, respectively, he has a permanent berth for 2008 in the British GT Championship, driving a Dodge Viper. We caught up with him after the season's opener at Oulton Park.

TO How does the Viper differ from the BTCC cars to drive?

PO'N Firstly, the Viper is rear wheel drive whereas the majority of modern BTCC cars have front wheel drive. This makes the Viper prone to over steer rather than the under steering characteristics common to front wheel drive chassis.

The Viper also has twice the power, is bigger and quite a lot heavier as well. The extra size and weight means it is not as agile as a touring car – but the acceleration is something else! It is important to preserve the tyres and brakes in any form of racing. With GTs this is particularly important. Not only do we have the extra weight to contend with but the races are normally based over a time period rather than a number of laps making the races of longer duration.

TO Is the Viper more physical to drive?

PO'N No, not really. The power steering works well and takes most of the strain. The cockpit temperatures don't seem any worse than in touring cars – but that's still very hot!

TO The start of the season went well!

PO'N Fantastic really. Top two 5 finishes is a nice start.. Oulton Park has always been good for me. I scored my maiden BTCC win here. It is the closest circuit to my hometown of Liverpool so I always have great support from the crowd.



We will catch up with Paul later in the season to look in more detail at driving issues and race performances.
